## ABOUT THE SEATTLE MUNICIPAL COURT

The Seattle Municipal Court (SMC) is one of the highest volume Limited Jurisdiction Courts in the State of Washington with seven elected judges and 5.5 appointed magistrates. SMC is authorized by the laws of the State of Washington and the Seattle Municipal Code to adjudicate misdemeanors, gross misdemeanors, infractions (e.g. traffic and parking tickets and other civil violations), and ordinance violations related to building and zoning codes.

SMC is committed to excellence in providing fair, accessible and timely resolution of alleged violations in an atmosphere of respect for the public, employees and other government entities. SMC is a contributing partner working with the Police Department, the City Attorney and the defense bar toward a safe and vital community.



The Court works with community organizations to increase access to services for residents and enhance compliance with court-ordered conditions. Court probation and day reporting staff monitor defendant adherence to court orders, assess treatment needs and help direct them to social service resources. The Court leverages additional outside agency resources with City funds to encourage defendants to successfully complete court orders.

# SR. DBA DEVELOPER/ENGINEER POSITION DESCRIPTION

Seattle Municipal Court's Court Technology Division is searching for **two** strong Senior IT DBA/Developers/Engineers to work with a cross-functional team to deliver IT solutions. These positions contribute to the court's ongoing operations by playing a key role in updating legacy systems. The ideal candidates for these two positions will have a track record of working with database schemas, data administration and troubleshooting performance issues. They will have experience using Informix.

If you have a background in using Informix, this is an outstanding opportunity to bring your database skills to the court and support our Municipal Court Information System (MCIS). MCIS stores a large volume of information required for the court to adjudicate misdemeanor and gross misdemeanor crimes, infractions and civil violations. SMC has plans for the replacement of MCIS and needs these positions to help support the existing system, participate on the project team for system replacement and provide future support after implementation. These two positions will report to the Court Information Technology Director.

## **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

- BA in Computer Science, Management of Information Systems, or related degree (or an equivalent combination of education, training and experience).
- 5+ years experience using Informix tools, utilities, and UNIX korn shell scripting.
- Successful candidates must have a proven track record in administering a large complex Informix database.

## **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

- This position requires occasional on-call, stand-by, overtime and/or weekend shifts.
- All offers are contingent on the verification of credentials, passing a background check and fingerprinting.
- This position is covered by the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers (IBEW), Local 77 union. As a condition of employment, incumbent will be required to pay union dues within 30 days of hire.
- New employees must successfully complete a 12-month probationary period prior to obtaining permanent status in this classification.
- This is a Civil Service position with automatic enrollment into the City's Retirement Program.
